PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS:

Jim Minor made a request for General Fund balances from August 2009 – March 2010 and a copy of the December 2009 minutes. Jim Rumble will check with Mr. Hook tomorrow about the guidelines regarding his request.

Bob Watson made a request to see the current financial report, which was available at the meeting.

Jack Keener wanted to see a record of mileage, fuel, and materials used. He also wanted to know where road patching was recently done.

There was a question about keeping the International truck. Jim Rumble reported that the township can save \$14-15.00 per ton on ashes by keeping the truck to haul them.
