Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Lou Kovach made a motion to approve the minutes from the July regular meeting. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Lou Kovach made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

CORRESPONDANCE: None

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill reported on work that has been done in the Township during the month of July. Bill and Lou finished Creek Road with crusher run, put crusher run on Beal Road and Lower Poland Mine Road, and millings on Sit Still Road. They cleaned Lower Sandy (storm), hauled the recycle trailer 4 times, did food bank, and removed downed trees from Donham, Poland Mine, and Leslie Roads. They removed limbs from

basically every Township road. Ditch lines were re-cut and grading installed on Lower Sandy Road. Ditch lines were cut and cleaned on Hillman Street. Ditch lines were re-cut and compacted on Maple Ridge Road. Mowing and weed-eating was done at the Township Building and at the Maletic House. The plans this week include starting on Sugar Grove Road to cut ditch lines and put down crusher run and millings on the steeper areas.

Bill reported that the Township received about 1,000 ton of millings from Chevron at no charge. Bill estimates that 200 tons have been used on Township roads so far.

Bill informed the audience that the supervisors are getting estimates for a building in which to store ashes. Quotes have been received from Log Cabin Fence Company.

George Gaynor asked about tree trimming and grass mowing in the Penn Pitt area. He said he had complained in the past to Supervisor Rumble and at a previous meeting and has seen no progress. Bill replied that he and Lou had been down there and the mowing had been done. Bill also asked why Supervisor Rumble had not reported the problems to him and Lou. Scott Neighbors said that Supervisor Rumble did not have to report them because he is not being paid to do so. Bill responded that Jim is still an elected official and supervisor and should have made the other two supervisors aware of any problems or complaints.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Lou Kovach to adjourn the meeting at 9:10 am. The motion passed unanimously.
