OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS & PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill Monahan made a motion to name Rocky King as a Township representative to the DVJMA Board. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Gary Tedesco of Tedco, Inc. addressed the Board. He operates a mining operation on the old Duquesne Light property in Glassworks. He explained that he will be mining close to DVJMA's water lines and the

water authority will not be able to discharge water for a period of time. He requested a meeting with the Supervisors and the Water Board to discuss a back-up plan so that the community continues to have water service.

Darlene Urban Garrett of the Elm Street Project addressed the Board. She requested that the Township become a part of the Elm Street Project with Greensboro Borough and left some informational material for the Supervisors to review.

Mary Shine asked the Board to consider letting the Nathaniel Greene Historical Society use the Maletic House for storing records and as a headquarters when they take over the Elm Street Project at the end of their contract.
