Jim Rumble called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Jim Rumble made a motion to approve the minutes from the May and June meetings. Bill Monahan seconded the motion, but again noted the discrepancies he found in Jim Rumble's mileage report.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS:

Nelson Smith requested that the Supervisors turn in monthly work records at the last meeting. Bill Monahan and Lou Kovach submitted their records from January 2012 through June 2012. Jim Rumble said he would turn his records in this week.

Nancy McIntire reported on a June 28, 2012 meeting with the County Earned Income Tax Management Committee. Some municipalities in the County are having problems receiving payments from CENTAX. The Committee is looking into what legal action needs to be taken to resolve the problem. Another informational meeting is scheduled for July 24 in Waynesburg on the matter.

Bill Monahan reported that work has been done on 10 Township roads in the last 6 months. Work has included gravel, road millings, pipe work, and cold patch. Bill thanked Lou Kovach for his work with Shallenberger Construction on obtaining the millings at no cost to the Township.

Bill Monahan reported that the recycling trailer at Mon View Park is working out well and is full every week.

The Supervisors have received several complaints from residents in Penn Pitt and Lower Sandy Run about abandoned properties and rodent problems. Larry Rogerson produced several Township ordinances addressing these problems. The Supervisors will discuss what actions can be taken.
