UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Jim Rumble will contact Attorney Hook about the Kois road map.

Jim Minor asked about the condition of the road outside the Township building. Jim Rumble responded that the engineering firm will only patch the holes and tar and chip the road. They have pictures and video of the road before they started the sewage project and are only liable for the damage they did.

There was discussion about granting permits to cross the road. Jim explained that blanket coverage of Township roads is supplied by Atlas. Lisa Miller suggested the use of Heavy Haul Permits similar to the ones used in Greene Township.

NEW BUSINESS:

Bob Watson asked about the new John Deere tractor. Lou explained that the tractor is on lease from Cambria Tractor and that a bid has been sent out for a tractor. Jim explained that the supervisors are trying this one out to see if they want to purchase it.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Dorothy Kennedy complained about the condition of her road: Fieldson Road. She said that it is washed out, has holes, 2 cars cannot pass, and the banks need mowed. Jim replied that the plan is to blacktop it in the next month and that it was mowed 2 weeks ago. Jim and Lou will drive out and inspect it after the meeting.

Jim Minor made a request for a copy of the minutes when Jim Rumble was appointed to the Sewage Board for the first time. He also questioned when the Highmark Health Insurance was canceled and what refund was received.

Jack Keener said that the gauge on the trucks is not working. Lou responded that a flow meter can be installed but has to be ordered.

Lisa Miller made a request that a flashing light be installed by her business because of dangerous speeding.
