**PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS:** None

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Bill Monahan voted "no" due to discrepancies he noted in Jim Rumble's mileage report, which he pointed out to the audience. Lou Kovach also voted no. The motion did not pass at this time.

Bill Monahan made a motion to rescind Tom Cumpston as vacancy board member. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Bob Watson thanked the Supervisors for patronizing his store. He also asked if the Township has the deed to the Maletic House in Glassworks. Bill Monahan responded that the Township has the deed and it includes the pavilion on the property. If the property is sold, it may have to be to a non-profit organization.

Larry Rogerson again questioned Jim Rumble's number of hours worked in the fourth quarter of 2011. Jim responded that 28 hours of overtime were spent stockpiling material around election day. Doug Saesan suggested that the supervisors keep daily work records to solve the problem of accountability.

Jim Minor pointed out that since the gauges have been placed on the fuel tanks, fuel usage has decreased significantly.

Larry Rogerson questioned the amount that is paid for health insurance monthly. He suggested that we question our insurance agent about the amount paid for supervisors on Medicare.
