PUBLIC COMMENT:

MINUTES CORRECTION: Jim Minor question a motion to correct the minutes of February's meeting to reflect an increase in taxes. Mr. Minor noted that the increase should be in the December 31 meeting minutes. Jim Rumble responded that the minutes were corrected.

SECRETARY HIRED: Jim Rumble made a motion to hire Nancy McIntire as the Township Secretary. Larry Lapana seconded the motion and the motion passed. The new bond has been received from the insurance company.

PURCHASE OF NEW VEHICLES: Rocky King questioned the appearance of two new vehicles outside. He questioned that any purchase over \$500. had to be approved at a public meeting and be bid. Jim Rumble responded that any purchase under \$10,000. does not have to be bid.

TAX COLLECTOR SALARY: Rita King asked if a decision had been reached by the supervisors regarding her current salary. She explained that since 2007 she has been receiving a \$2,220. salary instead of 5% of 100% collected. She has contacted Mr. Hook about this issue, and he informed her that the decision was the supervisors'.

Jim Rumble read a resolution dated February 14, 2005 that stated the change from a percentage to a salary effective January 1, 2006. Rita King responded that the change occurred in 2007 which violated the law that her salary cannot be changed in the middle of an elected term. She reported that her wages for 2005 were \$3,169.79, and for 2006 they were \$2,387.62.

Jim Rumble will discuss this issue with Mr. Hook tomorrow.

ROAD 708 ISSUE: Gwendell Nicklow reported a problem with snow plowing at his residence. He said that the plowing stops before his home and he feels he is being discriminated against. Jim Rumble explained that there is too much snow there for the trucks to handle. Larry Lapana suggested a snow fence is needed there to prevent drifting.

NEW TRUCKS: Robert Watson questioned the amount of the purchase of the new red truck. Jim Rumble responded that the price was \$7500. \$9500. was received from the truck that burnt and \$4000. of grant money was used to purchase the new trucks. Insurance will be dropped on the yellow International and it will be sold. Mr. Rumble also explained that the Township can now haul its own road ashes at a savings of \$760 this week. Also, the Township can now start stockpiling its own ashes.

WORK SCHEDULE: Jim Minor questioned the number of days and hours the supervisors worked this past week. Jim Rumble and Louie Kovach worked 7 days and Larry Lapana worked 6 days.

PEMA REIMBURSEMENT: Jim Rumble make a motion to apply for Pennsylvania Emergency Management reimbursement for snow emergency days February 5-7, 2010. Larry Lapana seconded the motion and the motion passed.

ADJOURNMENT: Jim Rumble made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:00 pm. Larry Lapana seconded the motion and the motion passed.
