Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

**PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS:** None

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Lou Kovach made a motion to approve the minutes from the October regular meeting. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

**CORRESPONDANCE:** None

**NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Bill reported on work that has been done in the Township during the month of October. Bill and Lou did tree and limb removal on Robena Road, paperwork and phone calls to PSATS, the solicitor, code enforcement officer, and State Police; welding and fabricating a screen for ashes, pulled recycle trailer 4 times, screened ashes, repair and maintenance on equipment, addressed several code violations,

worked on minor adjustments to the Township Building, cut roadsides on Kiger Road, Penn Pitt Drive, Shubert Road, Upper and Lower Poland Mine Roads, Penn Pitt, Fieldson Road, Center Lane, and Ford Street; and had emergency time clearing trees and limbs on Robena, Leslie, Hartley, Donham and Poland Mine Roads.

Bill questioned Jim about telling Township residents that the supervisors had “lost” the \$235,000. sewage grant. Jim responded that there “is no truth to that”. Bill explained that the Township attended the Commissioner meeting and received an extension on the \$235,000. grant, and received an additional \$178,607. 2013 CDBG grant for the East Dunkard water project. Jim insisted that he was told the Township lost \$60,000. of the sewage money and produced a paper which he refused to let Bill copy. Bill reiterated that NONE of the \$235,000. grant money has been lost.

Bill questioned Jim about documentation he was supposed to get from Atlas showing the Township received 1.3 million dollars worth of stone. Jim said he would get this at the May 2013 meeting, and to date has not produced any such documentation. Bill said that Jim has not been accountable for that.

Bill also questioned Jim as Chairman of the Sewage Authority about two seats on the Sewage Board. Tom Cumpston’s term had expired January 1, 2013 and the Township had never been notified. Also, Jerry Dorsey is a resident of the Township, but is appointed to a Borough seat. Jim replied that he also questioned Jerry Dorsey’s appointment, but was told it was allowed because he owned property in the Borough.

John Laskosky asked about road maintenance in Penn Pitt. He asked that tree limbs be cut and complained about residents creating junk yards with abandoned cars and illegally burning trash. Bill explained that he and Lou are “playing catch-up” trying to enforce ordinances that Jim had told them the Township did not have.

Trudi Monahan thanked Bill and Lou and Marita Gugliotta for donating candy for trick or treat in the Township. She wanted the residents to know that no Township funds were used this.

Jim Rumble asked about a letter he received from the DOT about vacating three Township roads. Jim made a motion to vacate the roads. Bill explained that he and Lou had not had a chance to review the letter, and tabled the motion.

**ADJOURNMENT:** A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Lou Kovach to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 am. The motion passed unanimously.
