Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the minutes from the June meeting. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill Monahan made a motion to adopt resolution #3-2014, Impact Fee Revenue Distribution. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill informed the audience that the Supervisors will be advertising for bids for tar and chipping of 4-5 miles of road. Rocky King asked which roads would be done. Bill said that the Supervisors would see what the contractor recommends after inspecting the roads. Bill also said that the Supervisors will be getting bids for an equipment building and looking to replace a tractor and boom mower.

Bill gave a report on work done during the month of June. Cold patching was done in Poland Mines (21 ton), Donham (17-18 ton), Hillman (10.5 ton), and Maple Ridge (7 ton). Roadsides were cut on Sigsbee, Upper and Lower Poland Mines, Ford Street, and Allison Street. Tree trimming was done in Penn Pitt and on Sigsbee Road.

Bill informed the audience that he, Mike, and Simon John attended a recent Greensboro Borough Council meeting and requested a third member for the Township on the DVJMA Board. He explained that the Township has more residents served, and according to the Municipalities Act of 1945, board members must be apportioned. The Borough also has a member on the Board who has missed at least the last 3 meetings.

John Laskosky thanked the Supervisors for patching the road in Penn Pitt where the water company fixed the lines. He also asked about Joe Kois' swimming pool (mosquito problems). Bill said that Frank Monarch from K2 Engineering was coming down this week to inspect some of the properties there.

Rocky King asked the Supervisors to clean a ditch line by his property.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Mike Rudolph to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 am. The motion passed unanimously.
