#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

#### **NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Bill Monahan made a motion to adopt Resolution #2-2014 to enter into an Agility Agreement with PENNDOT. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Mike Rudolph announced that a Township Cleanup Day will be held Saturday, May 17, 2014 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm at the Township Building. A dumpster will be available. Tires will be accepted for a fee and all electronics will be accepted free of charge. Notices will be printed twice in the newspaper and fliers distributed in the community.

Bill Monahan announced that a Township website will be started soon under the direction of Alan Laick, designer. Start up cost will be \$860. A \$95. yearly charge will be assessed thereafter.

Bids were opened and the following were awarded: \$700.00 for the 1995 Dodge truck from Joe Woodring, \$150.01 for the finish mower from Andy Fagula, \$100.01 for the 3 point blade from Andy Fagula, \$19.95 for the table and benches from Jim Minor, \$2515.00 for the 1995 Ford truck from Albert Rastoka, \$1550.00 for the Case Hi-lift from Saad Shadkami.

John Laskosky asked about a condemned sign for an adjacent property to his in Penn Pitt. Bill explained that Frank Monarch from K-2 would have to be contacted and Simon John, our solicitor, to do everything properly according to the law.

Larry Rogerson asked that a weight limit sign be replaced on Rosedale Street.

Lee Watson gave a presentation on the proposed BluePrint Community project. He explained that a 10-person committee has been formed and will be trained with the grant money. This project is being coordinated through the Nathaniel Greene Society as a 501-c organization. After a lengthy discussion, Bill made a motion to table the Township's participation in the project until future discussions can be had with our attorney and the public. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
