Keith Drew expressed the Fire Department's thanks for the Township's help with fixing their pickup truck. He asked for help with labor and installation of a diesel engine on a second truck. Bill Monahan made a motion to assist the Fire Department with this project. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.
