Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

**PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS:** None

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the minutes from the February regular meeting. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

**NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Bill Monahan gave an update on the Maletic House renovations. The first floor is almost completely done. The Supervisors purchased some hand tools for the inmates to do the work.

Bill reported that 6-650 tons of ashes and 35 tons of salt have been used so far this winter.

Bill also reported that John Kuis had visited the Township 3 weeks ago. The Supervisors were concerned that the public had not received the correct information regarding the recent PENNVEST grant/loan for the East Dunkard Water Authority. Mr. Kuis has said that John Over (K-2 Engineering) and Pam Snyder

(State Representative) declared that the project was not feasible. This is not true. Also, it had been proven that the project would have paid for itself, with a \$100,000.00 overage at the end of each year. East Dunkard Water Authority is now out of the picture. Dunkard Valley Joint Municipal Authority has now hired a new engineering firm – Thrasher Engineering.

Ed Cech asked if the directional valves had been installed on the ED lines. They have been.

Jack Keener asked about the holding tank amendment. Bill explained that was for campers.

June Hellen reported that Ms. Neino is complaining about a neighbor dumping garbage on her property. June also reported that her neighbor is not yet hooked up to the sewage system and is running sewage onto her property. She attended a recent Sewage Board meeting and was told that their attorney has not written any letters yet.

Bill informed the audience that anyone recording the meeting had to turn the recorder off after the meeting is adjourned. This is according to the wiretapping laws.

**ADJOURNMENT:** A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Mike Rudolph to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 am. The motion passed unanimously.
