Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the minutes from the March regular meeting. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill Monahan reported that water workshops have been held recently at the Township. Southwest Water has attended these and is moving forward with a feasibility study.

Bill explained the CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) funding available to the Township. The monies awarded for the Alicia Sewage Project in 2010 were placed on hold because the project would have resulted in an \$86.00/month cost to the 27 customers living in Alicia. An award was also received for the East Dunkard Water Project, which did not go through. Not a penny of the CDBG award money

has been lost, however. The Township is applying for an additional \$700,000. award this year, and hopefully all the CDBG monies can be redirected to the Dunkard Valley Water Authority.

Bill also explained that an amended 2014 audit report was published in the newspaper reflecting a \$42,310.00 excess in the General Fund. Larry Rogerson remarked that the Impact Fee Account revenues/expenditures should be listed separately as it does not accurately reflect normal business operations. Mike Rudolph explained that the Supervisors have been instructed to spend a portion of the Impact Fee monies or they may not receive them in subsequent years.

Mike Rudolph announced that the next Township Clean-Up Day will possibly be May 2, 2015. Specifics will be published in the newspaper.

Bill announced that the Township got a larger recycle trailer and may get a brand new one shortly. Sweeping of roads is to begin soon to get ready for cold patching. Stop signs and new 2-sided road signs are being installed. 210 ton of gravel was put down on Creek Road and compacted. The Township has also requested millings from PennDot, which is good for washed-out areas on the roads.

June Hellen asked about the possibility of the Food Bank being moved to the Maletic House. Mike Rudolph said the flow of people may be better down there. He said an Open House may be scheduled once renovations are complete.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Mike Rudolph to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 am. The motion passed unanimously.
