Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

**NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Rita King asked that the Supervisors set a day and time for her to turn in paperwork weekly.

Ralph Adams asked for a farm sign to be placed at Fieldson Crossroads. He is concerned about the bridge replacement project occurring in Mapletown July 10 – October 14, 2017. Ralph also asked about the possibility of a temporary or emergency bypass.

Ed Cech asked when the Dollar General store would begin construction. Bill Monahan said that it is now in the hands of the Greene County Planning Commission.

Trudi Monahan gave the Community Center update. Senior Day was held on May 18. Lunch was donated by Holly Shipley of Back Bay Catering. \$63.00 in donations was collected. The next Senior Day will be June 15 from 12:00 to 2:00 pm. Farmers' Market vouchers will be distributed with proof of income. Trudi reported that the Center was rented on May 19 by Mike Rudolph. She announced that the pavilion is now ready for rental and the price will be decided soon. Many electrical outlets have been installed at the pavilion for parties. Mike Rudolph made a motion to allow the Committee to proceed with a Dinner for Two for a Week fundraiser. Bill Monahan seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan reported that daylighting of township roads continues. 2/10 mile of Allison Road in Poland Mines was just completed. Bill said this will help cut down on storm cleanup and help with winter snow and ice melting. Mike Rudolph made a motion to pay J&M Contracting for the work in Poland Mines. Bill Monahan seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Bob Kelly complained of tree limbs laying on West Penn power lines on Kovach Road.

June Hellen complained of Penn Dot not mowing grass on Route 88 by the bank.
