Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mike Rudolph made a motion to accept a sub-recipient agreement with Greene County for the \$700,000.00 competitive grant that the Township had applied for. The grant is to install new water lines on Stoney Hill Road. The project will decrease the amount of the PennVest loan for the upcoming takeover by Southwest Water of Dunkard Valley Joint Municipal Authority. Bill Monahan seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan gave the following road work update. Several road washouts occurred during the

month of July. Several roads were repaired twice: Fieldson, Robena, Hartley, and Sigsbee. Road-side cutting and work on equipment was also done.

Trudi Monahan gave a report on Community Center happenings. Donations were taken for a gift card and gift basket raffle at the Cabbage Flats Yard Sale on July 15. \$1450.00 was collected. Scott Blair won the first-place prize and Sherri Bochna won the second prize. Winners are posted on the Township website. Trudi reported that the raffle was a huge success. Senior Day was held on July 20 and \$50.00 was collected in donations. The senior lunches will be paid through the end of the year from a grant applied for and received. August 17 will be the next Senior Day at the Center.

Trudi also announced a benefit to be held for two local children with serious illnesses. The benefit will be held at the Bobtown Shannopin Civic Club on Friday, August 11 from 6:00 – 9:00 pm. Two Bridges Road, a local band, will play at no charge. A Chinese auction, food, 50/50 raffle, and live music will be provided for a \$5.00 donation. Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the benefit and a \$350.00 contribution for food, water, and pop. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Mike Rudolph reported that the supervisors are looking into trading for a Massey Ferguson tractor with a side boom mower in excellent condition.
