Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

**PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS:** None

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Mike Rudolph made a motion to approve the minutes from the August regular meeting. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Mike Rudolph made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

**NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Kevin O'Malley gave the following legal update: Work continues on the subrecipient agreement with DVJMA and the Poland Mines abandoned car issue. Kevin will research the

possibility of using an independent auditor for this year's financial audit. Kevin recommended publishing the new ambulance services in the next newsletter, as the Greensboro Volunteer Ambulance Service is no longer functioning.

Bill Monahan gave the following road work update: Several washouts were repaired due to heavy rains on Leslie, Hartley, and Robena roads. Seven and a half tons of cold patch were used to repair Kovach, Poland Mines, Robena, and Hillman Roads. Roadside cutting, machine maintenance, food bank, and recycle trailer work was done. The supervisors also met with an engineer on the Robena Road project.

Trudi Monahan gave the following Community Center update: Games and activities are being provided through a grant. The Committee would like to thank everyone who contributed to the Rock the Donations fundraiser held on August 11. \$1100.00 was collected and given to the two families involved. The next Senior Day will be September 21. The Committee is beginning to work on the plans for the Halloween/Fall Festival.

Ed Cech asked to have weeds cut in Hillman and about the Fire Department cement project. Mike Rudolph reported that the fire department has received \$12,500. from the Township so far towards that project.

Bob Kelly asked what plans the fire department has for the ambulance they will no longer be using. He also asked about several neglected houses on Route 88.

June Hellen asked for a new stop sign and work to be done on her road. She also thanked the supervisors for their Food Bank work, given that the bridge has been out in Mapletown.

Kevin O'Malley addressed a question about the State Ethics Commission review. An anonymous complaint prompted a five-year review of all Township records. Kevin commented that after exhaustively reviewing all records, nothing unethical or illegal was found. Everything was found to be completely in order and within the law. Some financial interest forms were missing a checked box, but these were corrected and found totally acceptable. Kevin commented that the person who filed the complaint was completely wrong and did not have full understanding of Township law.

**ADJOURNMENT:** A motion was made by Mike Rudolph and seconded by Bill Monahan to adjourn the meeting at 9:25 am. The motion passed unanimously.
