OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Kevin O'Malley gave the following legal update: Recovery letters are ready to mail out on the Cox and Wolfe property cleanups. Bill Monahan made a motion to send the letters. Lou Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously. The supervisors will check the properties for any more garbage accumulated after the cleanups. The Yoskovich property purchase will be finalized by the title search company soon. The attorneys are corresponding regarding the Joe John property cleanup and a hearing has been requested. The DEP received the complaint and initiated the action and the supervisors want them to be represented at the hearing. Brian Lake of K2 Engineering sent a 30 day notice letter on the Kois demolition in Penn Pitt.

Fall Clean Up Day will be held on Saturday, September 26, 2020 from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm and will be advertised in the Observer-Reporter twice.
