Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

**PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS:** None

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Joe Kovach made a motion to approve the minutes from the March regular meeting. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Joe Kovach made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

**NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Bob Kelly asked for the county's dog catcher's phone number. He made several complaints of loose dogs on Kovach Road.

Kevin O'Malley gave the following legal report. A letter was received from the Edgar Snyder law firm regarding a traffic accident on Route 88 on January 23, 2021. Kevin will notify the township's liability insurance carrier of this notice.

Penn Dot removed three township roads from the liquid fuel list. Kevin explained that ingress or egress cannot be affected by this or any road abandonment. Joe Kovach made a motion to accept township resolution 2-2021 addressing this issue. Bill Monahan seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

The township has filed a complaint with the magistrate regarding the Cox property cleanup. Certified mail has been sent and the constable may have to serve him. Failure to respond may result in a default judgement and eviction. Bill Monahan made a motion to clean the garbage from the property while it is in litigation to mitigate further property damage and expense. Joe Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to give K2 Engineering permission to advertise for tar and chip bids for 2021. Joe Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

The supervisors agreed to sell the 1999 Ford F550 truck to Greensboro Borough for \$2500.00.
