Kevin O'Malley gave the following legal report: He reviewed the tax abatement ordinances received from the County Planning Office. Kevin reported that we are waiting for a court order to turn the Cox property over to the Sheriff for sale. A letter was sent on the Kois property demolition and no response was received. K2 will request three or four bids for the teardown. Seal and coating will begin this week and the anticipated end date is September 17. PennDot approved this date since no liquid fuel monies are being used for the project.
