Bill Monahan called the special meeting to order at 9:00 am.

**NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Joe Kovach made a motion to accept the resignations of tax collector Rita King and deputy tax collector Angela Liggett. Bill Monahan seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Patrick Sweeney explained that he was the business manager for the Southeastern School District for almost 20 years, retiring from that position in June 2023. During his time there, he was the driving force in making the tax collection process more efficient through implementation of the RAC software program and the Diamond Vue mailing process for 4 municipalities. Patrick explained that he has a thorough understanding of the tax collection process, works well with Greene County personnel, and is ready and able to accept the responsibility of the tax collector job.

Lou Kovach made a motion to appoint Patrick Sweeney as the tax collector for Monongahela Township. Joe Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Kevin O'Malley said that he would send Rita King a letter asking for the return of hardware used in the tax collection process (laptop, printer, scanner, flash drives) that was purchased by the school district and the township.
